

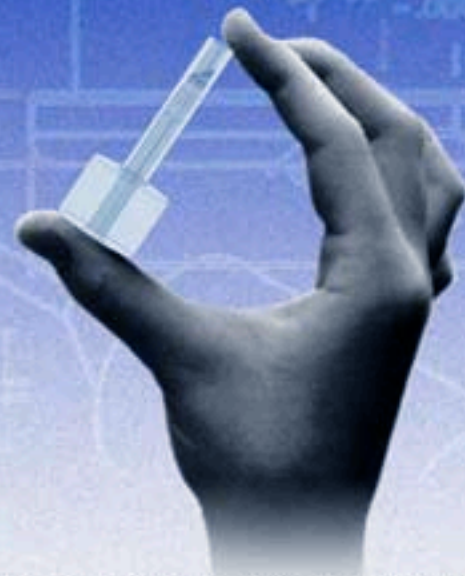

Elec-tro-form

Pronunciation: i-tek-tro-form - to form by electrodeposition on a mold or mandrel. If electroforming is new to you, here is how the process of electroforming a tipping die works:



From your catheter or die design, we develop an electroforming mandrel design. The mandrel tip has the same features as the finished catheter tip



NiCoForm will manufacture a mandrel.



The tipping die is formed by electroplating NiCoForm onto the mandrel to a desired thickness, then separating the die from the mandrel. Many identical dies can be made from the same mandrel.

An electroformed tipping die is only as good as the mandrel from which it is formed. Our mandrel manufacturing is done in-house to the tightest specifications in our state of the art CNC machining department. All mandrels and finished dies get inspected on our Mitutoyo 20:1 optical comparator, microscopes, and other inspection equipment. QC Inspection Reports are available upon request. Quality is number one at NiCoForm.
